This year the International Institute of Minnesota will are expecting 75 newly arrived refugee families from around the world, including those from Afghanistan and Ukraine. You can help support this work by organizing a Housing Donation Drive. Drive organizers play an essential role in welcoming new families by sourcing donations from friends, family or through service opportunities. Organizers also sort supplies to ensure that they are fit for distribution and deliver these supplies to the Institute to be used in housing set ups.
